Important Information

- 1. Please apply for a visa at least **two months prior** to the expected visit date. Note: sending the visa application and receiving reference number do not guarantee your application is ready to be treated.
- 2. Our consulate can approve **only temporary visit visas (B2).** For all other visa types (i.e. work visa, religious workers etc.) please turn to the Population and Immigration Authority in Israel.
- 3. In general, the consulate of the state of Israel can issue visit visas for **our** state's territories only.
- 4. **Spouses of Israeli citizens** can apply only through the Population and Immigration Authority bureaus in Israel invited by their Israeli spouse.
- 5. The visa's fee is 17JD.
- 6. Please attach to the visa application two personal photos (5 cm x 5 cm **only**). Photos of other sizes will not be accepted!
- 7. When attending the consulate please **do not bring with you** any electronic devices,i.e. mobile phones, laptops etc., in order to ease your entrance to the consulate.

Applying for a Visa

• In order to apply for a visa to Israel all you have to do is click the Application form link and fill up the application form, then press "send" at the bottom of the form. Before sending the application, please print out the form (the "print" click is at the bottom of the form), sign the application at the bottom of the form and bring it with you to the interview at the consulate.

Please bring with you:

- 1. The application form (fully filled and signed).
- 2. Your current passport (valid for at least 6 months) and older passports (if you have them with you).
- 3. Two clear personal photos with a white background sized 5cm x 5cm (other sizes are not accepted).
- 4. A family book.

 Kindly see below what additional documents are needed.

Please note that our consulate does not issue visas "on the spot". When we finish our process (several days after the interview) we will invite you to collect your passport.

Visa for minor

- The visa's fee is non-refundable.
- 2. Please keep the receipt that you get during the interview for collecting the visa at the end of the process.
- 3. If you would like to apply for a visa for a minor (under the age of 18), the accompanying adult needs to attend the interview with a signed parental/guardian approval, from **both** parents.
- 4. Foreign citizens who reside in Jordan must provide a residence permit in Jordan, valid for at least 3 months.
